## Why work with us?

- You have **full autonomy** to decide which clients you feel comfortable working with, your work hours and case load, and when you have space to see new clients. **No KPIs or other business pressures**. We treat you like the professional you are, and how we ourselves want to be treated.
- **Attractive remuneration**. **Psychologists** are paid **\$100-\$160 per billable hour + Super** (depending on factors incl. experience and needs from the workplace), e.g., If you opt for a caseload of average 20 clients a week, working 46 weeks a year (i.e., 6 weeks leave/year), you'll have a take-home annual income of \$92,000 to \$147,200 + superannuation + PD allowance. - **Annual professional development allowance** (\$500 to \$1500 per year).
- Fortnightly **individual supervision** sessions with Jasmine, in your first 3 months, then ongoing monthly sessions.
- Jasmine is a **Board Approved Supervisor**, so if you are an Ed. & Dev. Psych. registrar, arrangements can be made with Jasmine to be your registrar program supervisor.
- **Training** with Jasmine on working in the **neurodivergent** space, if you're just starting out in this area of work.

## Essential selection criteria:

1. ABN or willingness to procure one.
2. Full registration with AHPRA, or your profession's Australian regulatory board.
3. Experience working with neurodivergent clients using a neuroaffirming approach, or a special interest in this area and willingness to gain experience.
4. Experience delivering evidence-based services, e.g., CBT/ACT/DBT etc for psychotherapy.
5. Experience conducting a range of assessments, e.g., cognitive and educational assessments, ASD and ADHD diagnostic assessments, cross-battery assessments, etc., and strong report-writing skills (*#5 is only required for certain professions*).
6. Strong commitment to ongoing supervision & professional development.
7. Experience and confidence working independently with a wide range of presenting issues, together with a clear sense of the limits of your competency.
8. Strong work ethics, organisation, and verbal+written communication skills with key stakeholders.
9. Medicare provider eligibility (except for couples/family therapist/ counsellor).
10. Current Police Check and Working with Children Check (WWCC).
11. Professional indemnity insurance & full Australia working rights without limitation.

## Desirable criteria (any of):

- Bilingual/ multilingual working proficiency.
- Competence in delivering treatment modalities for trauma (e.g., EMDR, TF-CBT, etc) for therapists.
- Competence in delivering treatment for eating disorders (e.g., FBT) for therapists.
